Thy will be done

od's will, entirely shown to us in the Prophetic Scriptures and daily taught by the Holy Spirit to those who let themselves be instructed and led by Him to the whole truth, includes two commands: the command of doina and the command of not doing. No one might ever obey the command of doing if one does not first entirely obey and give fullness of fulfilment to the command of not doing. It is upon the command of not doing that one raises the command of doing. When the Lord wanted to stipulate a covenant of life with his people, He wrote the tables of the Law. Now only two are the commandments of doing on these table: Remember the Sabbath day and keep it Holy and Honor your father and mother. All the other commandments are law of not doing. What will the people of

the Lord not have to do if they want to remain people of the Lord eternally? They shall have no other God's before the one who delivered them from the slavery in Egypt. They shalt not take the name of the Lord the

God in vain. They shall not kill. They shall not commit adultery. They shall not steal. They shall not bear false witness against their neighbour. They shall not covet your neighbour's wife or husband. They shall not covet your neighbour's goods. If these eight laws of not doing are not observed, there is no life for the people of the Lord, for there is not the Lord who is the Giver of every life and of every blessing. Today one thinks to do the good, to be pleased to God in doing some work of charity or of mercy both in spiritual and material order. These works are useless, if first we do not obey the command of not doing. Neither is the prayer pleased to the Lord - He even proclaims the worship itself an abomination – if the obedience to not doing lacks.

Here is how the prophet Isaiah proclaims this most high truth: "What care I for the number of your sacrifices? says the LORD. I have had enough of whole-burnt rams and fat of fatlings; In the blood of calves, lambs and goats I find no pleasure.

When you come in to visit me, who asks these things of you? Trample my courts no more! Bring no more worthless offerings; your incense is loathsome to me. New moon and sabbath, calling of assemblies,

octaves with wickedness: these I cannot bear. Your new moons and festivals I detest; they weigh me down, I tire of the load. When you spread out your hands, I close my eyes to you; Though you pray the more, I will not listen. Your hands

are full of blood! Wash yourselves clean! Put away your misdeeds from before my eyes; cease doing evil; learn to do good. Make justice your aim: redress the wronged, hear the orphan's plea, defend the widow. Come now, let us set things right, says the LORD: Though your sins be like scarlet, they may become white as snow; Though they be crimson red, they may become white as wool. If you are willing, and obey, you shall eat the good things of the land; But if you refuse and resist, the sword shall consume you: for the mouth of the LORD has spoken!" (Is 1.11-20). When do we know to be pleased to the Lord? When our life obeys to every command of not doing. If we do not obey to not doing, for us there will never be enjoyment before God. Every member of the body of Christ must know what the Lord commands not to do. Obeying to not doing, one will be able to begin a true path of spiritual growth, entirely dedicating his life to do what was commanded, what is commanded.

Sign of created hope and solace

hen can the Virgin Mary create hope and solace in our hearts? When we take Her as our true Mother and raise Her to Queen, Governor, Leader, Lady of our life. But also the true anthropology can never be made as a new creature, for the Spirit makes as new creatures only in the mystical womb of the Mother of God. This is the great

mystery wrapping our Mother. Virgin Mary, come to our rescue. Make us mystery of your mystery to be mystery of Christ the Lord, mystery of the Father and of the Holy Spirit, mystery of hope and consolation for the Church and of the world.

Responses of Faith

If preaching the Gospel to each creature of every people, nation and language is a command of the Lord, why are many people saying that it is not to be preached today?

Preaching the Gospel is true command of Jesus. What is the principle that must lead the missionary of the Gospel so that his obedience be full and perfect? The inspiring principle must be only one: no man has the power to abrogate this command of the Lord. To whoever had to prevent us from preaching the Gospel to every creature, we are called to reply in the same way as Peter has replied to the chiefs of the Sanhedrin:

"Observing the boldness of Peter and John and perceiving them to be uneducated, ordinary men, they were amazed, and they recognized them as the companions of Jesus. Then when they saw the man who had been cured standing there with them, they could say nothing in reply. So they ordered them to leave the Sanhedrin, and conferred with one another, saying, "What are we to do with these men? Everyone

living in Jerusalem knows that a remarkable sign was done through them, and we cannot deny it. But so that it may not be spread any further among the people, let us give them a stern warning never again to speak to anyone in this name." So they called them back and ordered them not to speak or teach at all in the name of Jesus. Peter and John, however, said to them in reply, "Whether it is right in the sight of God for us to obey you rather than God, you be the judges. It is impossible for us not to speak about what we have seen and heard." After threatening them further, they released them, finding no way to punish them, on account of the people who were all praising God for what had happened. For the man on whom this sign of healing had been done was over forty years old." (Act 4,13–22).

One must obey God and not men. No man has power over the commandments given by Him spread. With devilish and satanic cunning one is spreading the word that will never have to be put in the heart by the disciple of Jesus: "One should no longer ask no one for the conversion to the Gospel and this is why the Gospel must not be preached."
