God might never bless his non-will

t is a right thing to highlight a truth, necessary today so that we deliver the mind of every man from every confusion and mistake governing and leading it. Without this truth, men will always give ignorant speeches, speeches with no science, speeches as ignorant. Religion or the bound that unites man to God is not an artificial bond, a bond thought by men, a bond imagined by us. Also used by us sometimes to subject men to our will passed for divine will. Religion or the bond with God is an event of nature, reality of creation. Man has not made himself. One can make him, either. One can also make him for pride and devilish arrogance. However, one makes him for the death and not for the life. But we

When man subtracts himself to God, the breath of the creation no longer wraps earth and it acts in a disordered and broken up way. It is as if it rebelled itself to man and no longer wants to serve him: "You man, do not serve your Lord and God, and I do not serve you."

The indissoluble union between a man and a woman, between one only man and one only woman, is an event of creation. If it is event of creation, of nature, it cannot succumb to men's will. God does not depend on any created will, both faithful will and unfaithful will. He has created you. He has said to you what the way where to walk

The indissoluble union between one only man and one only woman is event of creation, of nature, it cannot succumb to men's will is. If you obey, you are creator of life. If you disobey, you are creator of death. It is universal law, for it is law that must govern every created nature. God has decided what bound with him will have to be. Man has not been the creator of this bound. God has established this

bound since the own moment of the creation, when He has made man in his image and likeness, when He has created man as male and female. Man is unity made up of a male and a female. Man must recompose

only this unity of creation on earth. All the other re-compositions are neither unity nor union. They are only staying together as a stone is next to another stone. A stone might never create unity and union with another stone. This means that the man created by God might be man only if he respects his truth of creation, truth of male and truth of female, in perfect and equal dignity. The slavery of the woman over man or of the man over the woman is fruit of the sin that is separation of man or of woman from God. If man and woman depart from God, they will always depart from themselves with all the tragedies and the familiar disasters this separation involves. Since God has thought only this union and not other ones, all the other "unions" that man thinks to be willing to create, will never be "unions" for the Lord. If they are not for the Lord, the can be so for man, either. Consequently, no one might bless them in the name of the Lord. He would bless the non-will of the Creator and Lord. Might Christ ever bless the non-will of his Father? If Christ cannot bless it, why do some of his ministers bless it?

Those who still think according to the most pure truth of Christ Jesus are accused by the children of the Church of: strict morality, clericalism, traditionalism, spiritual oldness, incapability of entering the new world, anchorage to a past that no longer exists, evangelic fundamentalism, castling of one's own heart, spiritual insensibility, theological and anthropological blindness. The Virgin Mary must also deliver the hearts from the convincement that the evangelic truth is an artificial superstructure of the religion. It is urgent for the world to be convinced that religion is not

an artificial superstructure, created by some men for other men.. Religion is essence of man for man has been created by God and only if he breathes the breath of God, he lives, otherwise he is only creator of death for himself and for the others. History has always testified – and will always testify – that without the worship of the true God, man has been a monster for the other man and will continue to be so. May the Mother of Jesus help us accept this essential, fundamental truth.

If we do so, we offend the Spirit of the Lord very seriously, since we force Him to say what He has never said and has never thought. Thus acting, in the name of the Spirit of truth, we deceit men with our lies and falsities. Betraying the Scripture in the name of the Spirit is a very serious sin.

Responses of Faith

Why can anyone read the Scripture is one is not in the Holy Spirit? What are the dangers that are created from a reading of the Word of God without the Spirit?

he true prophets of the living God say the Word of God, but of the Word they say they know only what the Lord reveals them. What the lord does not reveal of the Word uttered by them remains obscure for them. This law is worthy for all the hagiographers

both of the Old Testament and of the New Testament. If this is worthy for the prophets, much more is worthy for the interprets of the Word. They too need the constant help of the Holy Spirit, not only of his science and fortitude, not only of his counsel and understanding, but also of his science or knowledge. Jesus begins his mission. John does not know through which ways Jesus will have to pass and this time he sends to Him to ask: "When John heard in prison of the works of the Messiah, he sent his disciples to him with this question, "Are you the one who is to come, or should we look for another?" Jesus said to them in reply, "Go and tell John what you hear

and see: the blind regain their sight, the lame walk, lepers are cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, and the poor have the good news proclaimed to them. And blessed is the one who takes no offense at me." (Mt 11,2-6). Those who are at the service of the Word will never have to forget this truth: they have the letter of the Scripture. They do not have the Holy Spirit, though.

To scrutinize the letter of the Scripture, one must be filled with the Holy Spirit. Not only the Spirit of wisdom

One must be unclothed of every thought and desire, since only the thought of God is drawn from the letter of the Scripture and given as nourishment to every man and of understanding, of fortitude and of counsel, but also and above all of the Spirit of science and of knowledge. Without the Holy Spirit governing heart, mind, soul, spirit, feelings, will, desires, thoughts, one makes the letter say what our heart wants it to say. While if one is filled with Holy Spirit, the letter of the Scripture will say only what the Holy Spirit wants to be said. This is why it is needed for every person who puts himself at the service of the Holy Scripture to be clothed with great humbleness. Being servant of the Scripture is being voice of the Holy Spirit. If one is servant and voice, one must be unclothed of every thought and desire, since only the

thought of God is drawn from the letter of the Scripture and given as nourishment to every man. Nothing must come from man's heart. May the Virgin Mary clothe us with her humbleness.
