Offence is the sinful use of our body before the little in faith or in age. With offence, another ruinous pestilence, evil enters the heart and the mind of our brothers and lead them to ruin. Responses of Faith

Who is truly the disciple of Jesus? What is his vocation in history? From what can we acknowledge that a Christian is true disciple of the Lord?

ne does not become disciples of Jesus once forever. The disciple is the one who learns from his Teacher every moment. He walks behind his Teacher. He follows his Teacher wherever He goes. He listens to each of his Word. He obeys each of his desire. If we do not do it, even if we say to be true disciples of Christ Jesus, we are not actually. We do not follow the footprints. We do not listen to his voice. We do not

live according to his teachings. We do not obey his Word. Every contradiction, little or great, we introduce in his Word, makes us little disciples of the Lord. If then there is the total detachment from the Word, then the Christian becomes disciple of himself, he is a disciple of his thoughts, of his sins, of his vices, of the non-love for Christ Jesus. If we say that one must not make disciples because all the religion are ways of salvation, we are not certainly disciples of Jesus. We do not listen to his voice. If we say that baptising and not baptising is the

same thing, for there is no advantage of the baptised over the non-baptised, beyond the advantage and the disadvantage, there is a Word of Jesus that we deny. We are not disciples of Jesus. If we are not true disciples, we are dried branches of the true vine that Jesus the Lord is. If we are dried branches, we cannot bear any fruit. The true vine, namely Christ Jesus, bears the salvation

through his branches that are his disciples. If the branch dries, this branch makes the true vine not bear any fruit of salvation. But also if the living branch does not bear other branches with his missionary work, the salvific and redeeming force of the true vine is strongly limited. Today we must confess that being many Christians no longer disciples of Jesus, true living branches, the salvific and redeeming force of the true vine is strongly limited.

Not only is it strongly limited, one neither believes that the true vine is the only one that bears fruits of redemption and of salvation. Today every wild vine is raised to vine that produces true salvation, true redemption, true sanctification. However, then history disproves our false teachings and each of our oracle of sin that comes out of our moth. Here is then why not only is it necessary that we become disciples of Jesus. To being, us, true disciples, we must add a most intense missionary work so that every other man becomes living branch of

the true vine that Jesus the Lord is. More branches we give to the true vine and more salvation and redemption will be done in the world.
