y Father, who is also your Father, perfect in love, has given me for your salvation. I, perfect in love, have given myself as Crucified for your salvation. You, in me, with me, through me, must give yourselves from the cross for the redemption of every man. Can the one who is called in Christ to offer himself for the

of the love of righteousness and of holiness that is commanded by God in the Old Testament, the Christian must add the sublimity of the crucified love of Christ Jesus. The Crucified makes the difference between the love commanded in the Old Testament and that commanded in the New.

Today and for eternity, the Crucified is the truth of our love. A love not in the image of the Crucified is either non-love or very imperfect love. Another truth: having we to love in the image of the Crucified, can us resist the evil? Jesus has let himself be crucified by evil. He has even given his cloak and garment. For the evil He ahs poured his blood so that they may let themselves be reconciled with God. Before such a high example, there are no earthily reasons that may abrogate this eternal Law of Christ Jesus, Law that He has

Today and for eternity, the Crucified is the truth of our love. A love not in the image of the Crucified is either non-love or very imperfect love lived, making Himself obedient to it until the death of cross. This commandment declares every riot, every fight, every contraposition, every war, every violence non- Christian. The one who does not imitate Christ Jesus also in this commandment can

never say to be Christian. Instead, today the Christian is a fomenter of every riot, every fight, every violence, every offence, even very serious, caused to God, to his nature, to each of his brother and does such things with the blessing of the ones who, by now, have as their unique law the thought of man. May the Mother of God never let us bless what the lord can never bless: the sin and the transgression of his Law.

he Holy Spirit, through Ecclesiastes, reveals that man is obedience to the Commandments of the Lord. In the obedience, man is. In disobedience, man is not. In the accumulation of richness man is no, for he is from death. This is the great foolishness of man: accumulating richness, becoming idolater, losing soul and body for eternity. Utmost foolishness and ignorance!

Thus the Holy Spirit says: "Because of the precept, help the needy, and in their want, do not send them away empty-handed. Spend your money for your brother and friend, and hide it not under a stone to perish; Dispose of your treasure as the Most High commands, for that will profit you more than the gold. Store up almsgiving in your treasure house, and it will save you from every evil; Better than a stout shield and a sturdy spear it will fight for you against the foe." (cf. Sir 29,1-13). It is most pure truth. The Word of Jesus is always fulfilled. The accumulated richness will always be for robbers and burglars, for moths and rust. They lock the gates of the kingdom of heaven for us. No accumulator of richness will never enter the eternal kingdom. His heart is not in heaven for his treasure is the richness. Professing oneself as devoted children of the Mother of God is not enough, one must also think according to the heart of the Mother of God and proclaim the truth of God as She has proclaimed it. Can the one who walks in the history clothed with hellish darkness ever be devoted child of the Woman clothed with the sun, since with his words he does nothing but abrogating the entire Divine Revelation and every supernatural and eternal mystery? Can he ever say to be child of the

Mother of Wisdom, he who with his foolish and ignorant words affirms and proclaims that God is only mercy and that He accepts everybody in his eternal kingdom? The true devotion toward the Virgin Mary consists of that: of thinking as She thinks, of obeying the Word of the Lord as She obeys, of speaking of God with most pure truth as She speaks, of loving her Son, Christ Jesus, as She loves Him. Of believing in the Divine Word as She believes. If we do not think as She does, our devotion is only great hypocrisy. We hide behind her love to deceive our brothers.

ur God is the eternal faithful. He is faithful to every Word uttered by Him. He has never been unfaithful to one only Word come out of his mouth. The son who abandons the dwelling of the Father is not faithful in his obligations of love. Instead, the Father remains faithful to his love of Father and accepts the son who repented and humiliated turns back to Him. History

is war, contrast, riot, quarrel, genocide, hatred, envy, suppression, crucifixion, death, revolution, but also famine, extreme poorness, endless misery, pestilence. In this sea of the history always stormy, what does Jesus ask his disciples? One only thing: to remain faithful to the Word given to Christ Jesus, to his Gospel, to his truth, to his righteousness, to his holiness. One remains faithful living in the Gospel, obeying each of his Word. In obedience is the eternal life. In disobedience is the eternal death. In faith is theendless life. In unfaithfulness is the perdition forever. The Christian does

not ask Christ Jesus to deliver him from history that will always be stormy. Instead, he asks for the grace to remain faithful to the Word.

One remains faithful obeying every Word of Christ Jesus every day. The obedience is perfect if perfect is the love with which one obeys. When love is imperfect, also the obedience is imperfect. Here is what the Holy Spirit says: "To the angel of the church in Ephesus, write this: " 'The one who holds the seven stars in his right hand and walks in the midst of the seven gold lampstands says this: "I know your works, your labor, and your endurance, and that you cannot tolerate the wicked; you have tested those who call themselves apostles

> but are not, and discovered that they are impostors. Moreover, you have endurance and have suffered for my name, and you have not grown weary. Yet I hold this against you: you have lost the love you had at first. Realize how far you have fallen. Repent, and do the works you did at first. Otherwise, I will come to you and remove your lampstand from its place, unless you repent. But you have this in your favor: you hate the works of the Nicolaitans, which I also hate. " "Whoever has ears ought to hear what the Spirit says to the churches. To the victor I will give the right to eat from

the tree of life that is in the garden of God."" (Rev 2,1-7). One walks from faith to faith, walking from imperfect love to more and more perfect love. In any storm of history, neither the most savage and inhuman, cruel and pitiless one, the disciple must fall from love. Rather, the more the storm rages and the more his love will have to be greater.
